2004 Pinot Noir – Dry

Also known as Pinot Noir, this dry German Spätburgunder is an elegant, easy to drink, velvety wine with a distinctive bouquet reminiscent of almonds or blackberries. Crafted in traditional German style, it is lighter in color, body and tannic acidity than its counterparts from warmer climates. This dry red is excellent with strong cheeses, pastas with red sauce, light meat dishes, venison and goose. This wine comes from a stainless steel tank, which allows you to taste the pure grapes and soil and not the barrel.

Alcohol: 12,12 % Vol.
