### 2004 Pinot Grigio – Dry

This dry Pinot Grigio, the white sibling of the red Pinot Noir, is a wonderful dry white from the clay and loam hills of Rheinhessen in Germany. Where Romans 2000 year ago planted their wines, today we can enjoy grapes harvested from the same soils and produce this superb Pinot which goes well beyond most Pinot Grigios. You won't taste oak, just a clean and refreshing taste. Crisp, but complex, the wine has tones of grassy melon and a mild wildflower bouquet with light lemon-citrus flavors, which makes it very attractive. This is a great wine that goes well with almost anything—pasta dishes, seafood, i.e. sushi and the lighter meals we enjoy in warm months. Serve chilled.
